	Hope	Hope - Children will consider how games have evolved and how they will continue to in the future. Children will discuss how we can aspire for things to be better and for us to use our talents to make positive changes.	Faith	Children will revisit the idea from their Reception Harvest project that God's Earth is an amazing thing and to recognise beauty in their local area. They will recap how Christians believe it is our duty to protect and care for the Earth.
	Joy	Joy will also be important as children will learn throughout their school journey about how we can find joy in both constants and changes. We will discuss how we all have different god given talents and will link this idea to the individuals who are experts in this field.	Compassion	Compassion will feature as children will learn about different animals, the struggles they face in their habitat and also will consider how mankind is having an effect on these species.
Year 1	Courage	Finally, children will consider how courage fits into inventing. They will explore how innovators must have courage to think outside the box, have their ideas rejected and be open to make changes.	Joy	Finally, children will continue to develop their appreciation of the surrounding local area and consider the joy in living here.
	Faith	Children will appreciate how individuals historically and in the modern day in this field must have faith in themselves, the science behind their profession and possibly a religious faith also.	Compassion	During this project, children will focus on compassion particularly considering different ways of life and understanding the similarities and differences of people in different places as well as protection of the environment and animals.
	Courage	Learning will explore how courage is essential for jobs where uncertainty is prominent and children will consider how this may affect life decisions and the families of individuals.	Joy	Joy will also feature as children will further appreciate the beauty and diversity of God's creation in the environment and animals. Children will also focus on opportunities to travel and visit different places around the world that offer new things to enjoy and how we balance this with protecting the environment.

Year 2

Hope

Finally, children will consider developments within aeronautics and how future progress can be made while protecting the environment, highlighting **hope**.

Faith

During this project, **faith** will be integral. Children will learn about specific leaders from the medieval period and will reflect on how we need to show faith in those who are in positions of power. This can be compared to children having faith in those who look after them and individuals having a faith in god

Faith

Children will understand how light features as key part of a religious **faith** across different religions. They will reflect on how this may affect the life of a religious believer and how the festivals involving light are important to them.

Compassion

Compassion will also help them to understand how people try to avoid conflict by understanding others.

Compassion

Compassion will feature as children reflect on how religious believers might act as a light for others through their words and actions. This can be developed through thinking about this in the context of our school and community especially ' Let your light so shine...'

Year 3

Courage

Courage will also feature as children learn about people who took part in invasions where their lives were at risk and how they decide on the correct path.

Hope

Hope will be explored through the symbolism of light and understand how light is a symbol of hope when times seem dark or without hope. They will also reflect on how light may bring comfort.

Courage

Learning will focus on **courage** by understanding the actions of Ramesses 1 in the way in which he flourished and taking time to reflect on how they are flourishing.

Joy

This project will focus on the value **joy** and loving and valuing the different people and places in the world. Valuing them for their similarities, differences and their uniqueness.

Joy

Joy will be central to the project as we explore art and dance and how this impacts on people's feelings. This will provide the opportunity to explore and further interest in and appreciation of the talents of others.

Faith

Faith will also feature as children will understand how areas of our world are fit for purpose and how Christians believe that God has provided us with all we need to steward his Earth.

Hope

Finally, **hope** will feature in the project as we learn about progress between ancient and modern civilisations and link this to our own thoughts about the future.

Joy

Joy will be a focal point due to the opportunities within the project as children explore both the joy within our locality's history but also within the practical elements of their learning and working together.

Children will understand the **joy** of hobbies and interests by focussing on Edith Pretty and how these effect people's lives. They will discover how her passion for archaeology led to some of the most amazing discoveries in her field
